1	The MCUI are empowered to decide on any questions raised within Ireland concerning the GCR, or the International Sporting Code.		
2	When giving judgement, the court of appeal must make an order as to the forfeiture or the return of the appeal fee and costs.		
3	Any protests arising from a Meeting shall be adjudicated by the Stewards of the Meeting.		
4	If a fine is not paid within the five-day period, the suspension of the member will continue until the fine is paid.		
5	Exclusion means the prohibition of any person from taking part in any capacity at an event.		
6	Event promoters must make adequate arrangements for the protection of spectators.		
7	In the event of a dead heat, competitors tying for a place shall divide any prizes amongst themselves.		
8	Application for a permit may only be made on the appropriate form.		
9	Alterations to the Supplementary Regulations may only be approved by the appropriate authority, or by the Steward of the Meeting.		
10	Helmets that don't meet MCUI approval can be worn at an event.		
11	A person may use an assumed name only with the approval of the MCUI/Centre.		
12	A visitor competitor can compete in an MCUI event with just their own national licence.		
13	The Clerk of the Course can also be Secretary of the Meeting.

14	The Clerk of the Course can have a casting vote at the Stewards meeting.		
15	The officials responsible for the supervision of the Meeting are the Stewards of the Meeting.		
16	All senior officials must be MCUI Official licence holders.		
17	No official shall perform any duties other than those appointed to them.		
18	The duty of the Steward of the Meeting is to ensure that the event is carried out in accordance with the GCR's.		
19	All Stewards reports should be completed on the day of the meeting.		
20	The Stewards reports should be returned to the Centre within 14 days following the meeting.		
21	Exclusion is handed down by the Stewards either before, during or after competition.		
22	MCUI have a concussion protocol.		
23	An official can be tested for alcohol at an event.		
24	Stewards meetings are necessary only after all MCUI events.		
25	All clubs must be aware of the Code of Practice and its contents.		
26	An official has got the right to protest the decision of the Stewards.		
27	A competitor can take out a licence for short circuit without completing pre-assessment and training.		
28	The Stewards of a meeting can re-run an event which has been completed.		
29	Motocross and grasstrack events must have a current track certificate and can the course be inspected by MCI.		
30	The Clerk of the Course can exclude a competitor from an event.		
31	The stewards of the meeting can overrule the GCR's to suit the running of the event.		
32	Changes can be made to the supplementary regulations after receiving entries.		
33	It is necessary to have approval of the authority granting the permit for all your nominated officials.
